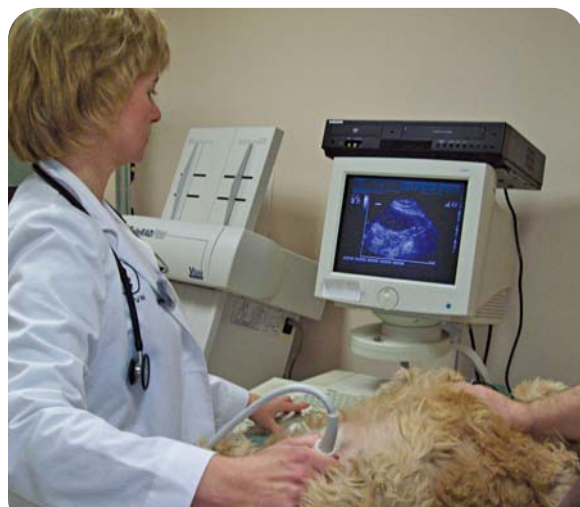
Wellness

Keeping your pets healthy is important to us, and regular wellness examinations are the foundation to helping them live longer, healthier, happier lives. Wellness care covers far more than vaccinations; it also includes preventive care such as heartworm and intestinal parasite testing, nose-to-tail exams and comprehensive evaluations of overall health.

In addition to dogs and cats, our doctors treat ferrets, rabbits, guinea pigs, hamsters and rodents.

Dentistry

Periodontal disease is the most common ailment found in dogs and cats over four years old. It can lead to pain and tooth loss, and the resulting bacteria can spread throughout the body and damage the heart, lungs, kidneys and liver. Our dental services include teeth cleaning and polishing, digital dental x-rays, tooth extractions and oral surgery.



Surgery

We perform many surgical procedures at our hospital, including routine spay and neuters, soft tissue surgeries, orthopedic surgeries and cryosurgery. Our surgical suite includes heated surgery tables and advanced anesthetic monitors that measure heart and respiratory rates, oxygen levels, body temperature and heart rhythm. Patients recover in our Intensive Care Unit, where they can be closely monitored by our experienced staff.

Pain Management

Your pet's comfort and well-being are very important to us. We provide a variety of pain control options tailored to the individual pet's needs. We utilize various medications, including anti-inflammatories and narcotics to keep your pet comfortable. Our therapeutic laser helps with post-surgical pain and healing, and alleviates chronic pain conditions such as arthritis.

Hospitalization

Hospitalized pets receive the highest quality of care. Our Intensive Care Unit has heated cages to keep pets warm and comfortable. The ICU is located in our treatment room and its glass walls allow doctors and staff to closely monitor all patients. In addition, we have an isolation area where pets with contagious illnesses can be treated safely away from other patients.

Diagnostic Testing

We are proud of our commitment to high quality care and have developed a diagnostic department that includes digital radiography, ultrasound, electrocardiography (ECG), blood pressure monitoring and tonometry (glaucoma screening). Our complete in-house laboratory is capable of performing many tests, including blood counts and chemistries, endocrine testing, blood gas analysis and microscopic evaluations. These services are complemented by additional outside laboratories and telemedicine consultations with specialists nationwide.

Pharmacy

Our extensive pharmacy allows us to accurately and efficiently dispense medications appropriate for your pet's medical needs. If you prefer the convenience of shopping from home, visit our online pet store and pharmacy, accessible on our website.

Behavioral Counseling

We can provide advice regarding the correction of problems such as excessive barking, chewing, scratching, digging, house soiling, anxiety and aggression.
